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## John 10"10-21

(Ps. 100:3) "Know that the Lord, he is God! It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture."

(Isa. 53:6) "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all."

### Truths about Sheep

**Sheep are D\_\_\_\_\_.**

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(Luke 15:3-5) "So he told them this parable: <sup>4</sup>"What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he has lost one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open country, and go after the one that is lost, until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing."

(Isa. 1:18) "Come now, let us reason together, says the Lord: though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall become like wool."

**Sheep are D\_\_\_\_\_ on a Shepherd.**

### Jesus is the Good Shepherd Because...

(John 10:11-14) "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. <sup>12</sup> He who is a hired hand and not a shepherd, who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees, and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. <sup>13</sup> He flees because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. <sup>14</sup> I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me."

(John 10:11) "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."

• **O\_\_\_\_\_ Dangers**

(John 10:18) "No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again."

(2 Cor. 5:21) "For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin..."

(Matt. 1:21) "You shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."

(John 10:14-15;17) "I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, <sup>15</sup> just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep... <sup>17</sup> For this reason the Father loves me, because I lay down my life that I may take it up again."

(John 3:16) "For God so loved the world,<sup>[a]</sup> that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

**...he u\_\_\_\_\_ the sheep.**

(John 10:16) "And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd."

(Isa. 42:6-7) ""I am the Lord; I have called you<sup>[a]</sup> in righteousness; I will take you by the hand and keep you; I will give you as a covenant for the people, a light for the nations, <sup>7</sup> to open the eyes that are blind, to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon, from the prison those who sit in darkness."

(Isa 49:6) ""It is too light a thing that you should be my servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob and to bring back the preserved of Israel; I will make you as a light for the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth."

(Matt. 28:18-20) "And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in<sup>[a]</sup> the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
